Frequently Asked **QUESTIONS'S** >>>

1. What is the GHCC Internship Program?

Our Internship Program is a one year program allowing you to exponentially grow your God-given gifts through ministry as you become a part of the day-to-day life of Good Hope Christian Centre. The program consists of weekly team meetings, leadership development, Bible School, department specific work and much more. You will be given the opportunity to work with and learn from great leaders, whilst growing in your spiritual walk with God. The Internship Program will challenge you, inspire you and stretch you to your full potential in building God's house. While interns will serve primarily in one ministry area, you will be exposed to a broad range of ministries and experiences

2. What does the ideal GHCC intern look like?

- Represents and lives a life fully committed to Jesus.
- Fully supports the vision of Good Hope Christian Centre, to Give Hope & Heal People.
- Is excited and willing to serve in any capacity with the ultimate goal of seeing people's lives changed and the advancement of God's Kingdom.

3. Week at a glance -

The internship program runs 4 days a week Tuesday - Friday and a full day (morning & evening) on a Sunday. Although normal office hours are from 8:30am to 4:30pm, there are many cases where interns may need to arrive early or leave late.

Tuesday: Interns start the week with devotions and join in on weekly departmental team meetings. We love Tuesdays because you get to evaluate the past weekend and gain valuable input that equips you with all the skills you need for upcoming weekly tasks.

Wednesday - Friday: Interns check in with their Department Head, have planning meetings, complete departmental work or projects, prepare for upcoming events, and more! Interns will also attend weekly Bible School evening classes through ICBC (see more information on our Bible School classes below).

Sunday: Interns arrive at church to serve in their respective department or volunteer area for the day. You will have a lunch break and then return to church for the evening services where you will continue serving. We love Sundays because you get to outwork everything you have learned in the week and see the difference you are making in each person who gets impacted by the message of Jesus.

Interns are involved in serving at all events hosted at Good Hope Christian Centre. Some annual events include: Camps, Easter & Christmas Productions, March of Hope, Appeal to Heaven Conference, Women's Day, etc.

4. How much does the internship cost?

The Internship cost is R6000 for the year. This can be paid upfront or over 10 monthly payments of R600. This fee is for participating in the Internship Program and does not include housing, food, transport or living expenses. You will also receive a completion certificate through ICBC at our year-end graduation.

5. Accommodation and Transport?

Accommodation is not provided by the GHCC Internship Program. Although the city has a public transport system for travelling it cannot be regularly relied on for punctuality and safety. While many people use public transport during the day, it's not an option in the evenings where you may be required to be available for work, as we have many evening services.

6. I've completed my first year, what's next?

We offer a 2nd Year Internship Program for those who want to continue on. Some go on to study or work and do what God has called them to. We believe God takes you on an incredible journey throughout the year and reveals your next season when the time is right. We take time to pray and chat about this.

7. Do I have to attend Bible School?

We require all interns to attend bible classes through International Christian Bible College (ICBC) fully accredited by, Transworld Accrediting Commission. ICBC courses are designed to help interns gain a strong biblical foundation and grow in their own personal walk with God. Being an intern with GHCC will also gain you a maximum of 24 ministry practical credits towards your ICBC studies.

8. What is the application process?

There are a number of important steps to follow when applying for the Inspire Internship Program.

STEP 1 - APPLY

STEP 2 - SUBMIT YOUR VIDEO

Using a Smartphone, please film a 1 minute video of yourself explaining why you want to join our Internship Program. Should you not be following the online application process, please email your video to us, along with your application form to, info@ghcc.tv.

STEP 3: MINISTRY REFERENCE FORM

Have your Ministry Reference Form (link) completed. If you are part of the GHCC family please ask your Volunteer Team leader or Campus Pastor to complete your reference form. If you are from another church, please have your local church pastor complete your form. Have your pastor or leader email the completed reference form directly to info@ghcc.tv. No ministry reference form should be handed in by the applicant his/her self.

STEP 4: INTERVIEW

You will be contacted by our internship team to schedule an in-person interview appointment.

STEP 5:

You will receive notification as to whether your application has been successful or not by our internship coordinator

Department **Descriptions**

PASTORAL CARE - Caring for our church

If you have a strong passion and love children you can help build and equip our children's ministry. HopeKids runs each Sunday morning for age groups (newborn-13). Not only will you be impacting the kids, but also the parents and the family as a whole. When you impact a child, you touch an entire family. Mid-week responsibilities will include but not be limited to, calling new families and building relationships, curriculum, scheduling and preparing for Sunday programs, using your creative skills for new decor, equipping yourself for upfront speaking, learning valuable skills on working with different age groups and learning how to build teams.

YOUTH - INFINITY/INFINITY XP

Interns in our youth department should be passionate about investing into the next generation of high school students. Our mandate is - Our Infinity youth leaders give heart & soul to impact the lives of the young people we see on Friday nights and make Church pumping on Sundays.

Infinity XP is the 18-25 year old young adults of GHCC. We bring Jesus to our young adults by meeting them where they are at in their season of life. We are passionate about teaching students that church is a place to be enjoyed and not tolerated. Youth interns will play an important role in planning Friday nights, organising youth conferences and camps and assisting in weekly youth groups across our campuses.

PRODUCTION TEAM

Our Production team interns get to be part of the engine of making church happen across all GHCC campuses on a weekly basis. They get to creatively express their worship to God through one of our many creative platforms. This includes but is not limited to our worship team (band), drama, dance, lighting, sound, camera & media team and more. This is a team of hard working individuals who will stop at nothing to make sure GHCC's vision and the Word of God continues to impact people's lives globally.

COMMUNICATIONS/MEDIA TEAM

The Communications and media department is responsible for all communication and media in and around Good Hope Christian Centre. Interns in this department have and will gain experience and skills in Graphic Design, Web Design, Videography, Photography and Social Media.
